For the common summer activity of eating watermelon, the speaker evokes three distinct senses—the *sight* of a sunny day, the *taste* of the fruit, and the *sound* of a wind chime. We, as readers, are both inside the room and outside it at the same time. The present continuous verb tense, without a subject pronoun, conveys the scene's timeless quality.
